



Slide Show Presentation

Dear Senior,

As part of our graduation ceremony, we will have a slide show presentation that spotlights each of you for approximately a little over a minute. Please make sure you read the requirements carefully and understand what you need to **submit to Mr. Stoner, no later than 3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 6, 2020.**

Slide Show Basics:

The slide show will consist of individual groups of pictures for each graduating senior. The order in which each senior will appear in the slide show will be alphabetical by the senior's last name. Each graduating senior will be responsible for providing his/her pictures. The slide show will also have music.

Picture Requirements:

Each graduating senior will need to provide **a maximum of 10** pictures (and music selection) for the slide show, including his/her senior picture that will be used as the last slide in the individual's group. Please be aware there is a possibility all 10 pictures will not be used, if the total number of graduates is larger than expected.

The guidelines are:

- Digital pictures only
- If you have prints, you can either scan the prints onto your computer to make digital copies or take them to a copy store and have them scanned for you.
- Specify picture sequence (01, 02, 03, etc...your senior picture will be number 10)

If you are providing digital pictures on a CD, the following will provide the best results:

- JPEG format
- High resolution digital pictures
- Close up shots are best
- Landscape orientation is best

ALL pictures with red eye will be corrected!



We are also asking each senior to include his/her choice of song, which we may be able to include before, during, or after the ceremony. We will not guarantee every song will be used. Your class song will already be included.

Music Track:

- Provide music that contains no profanity or sexual innuendos
- Provide music track on the same CD you use for your pictures.
- Use proper music “ripping” techniques
- MP3 or AAC format
- Original music can also be used
- Music track will play from beginning **UNLESS** you specify otherwise

Example:

Lindsey Hawkins has provided 9 pictures, including her senior picture (10 pictures total), and a music track. All pictures are digital pictures. She has provided all of this information on a CD. The folder on the CD is named *Lindsey Hawkins*. Inside this folder are two separate folders: *Pictures* and *Music*. The *Music* folder contains **one** song. The *Pictures* folder contains her 10 pictures which are labeled:

- Hawkins 01, Hawkins 02, etc.
- The senior picture will be named Hawkins 10
